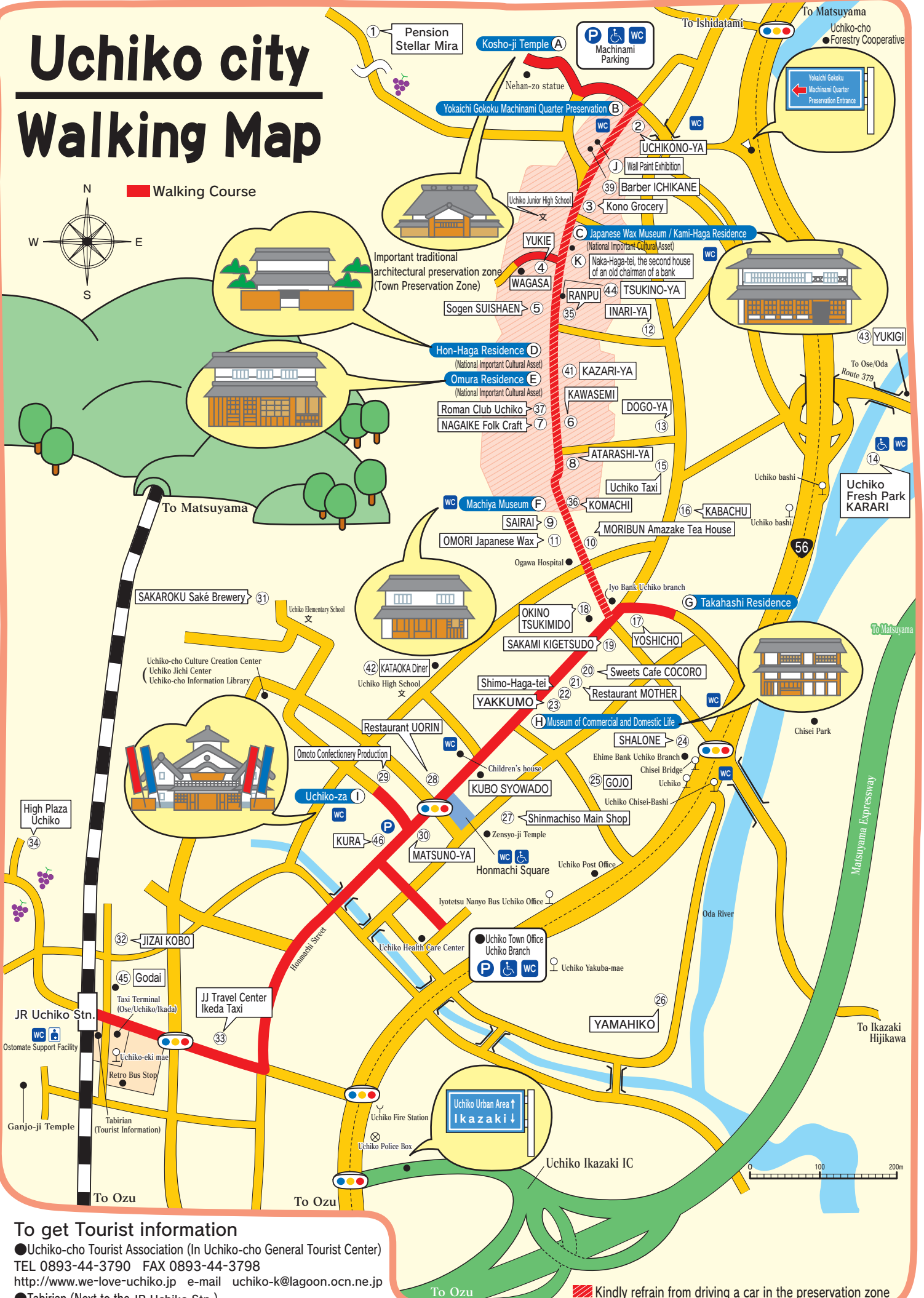
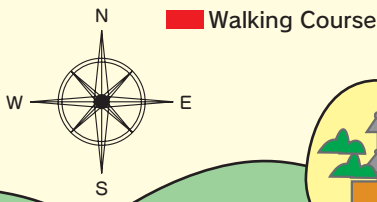


Uchiko city Walking Map

- ④ **Tea House YUKIE Yokaichi**
Have a tasty snack and a cup of coffee in this calm atmosphere featuring an old well. The home-made cheese cake has a good reputation.
- ⑤ **Sogen SUISHAEN Yokaichi**
Relax at this tranquil coffee shop with a view of a water fall and a water wheel. Hand crafts are on sale.
- ⑥ **KAWASEMI Yokaichi**
3,500 yen/person (prior booking essential)
Lunch: Noon to 14:30, Dinner: From 18:00 -
- ⑨ **SARAI Sakamachi**
Enjoy our rich-flavored coffee.
- ⑫ **INARI-YA Honmachi 8**
A restaurant established in the 1920's. Jumbo inari sushi udon, and Iroiyaki (prior booking required) have a good reputation.
- ⑭ **Uchiko Fresh Park KARARI Uchiko**
Uchiko product market and restaurant are popular.
- ⑯ **KABACHU Honmachi 6**
A Chinese restaurant for the one who has a big appetite. Deep fried food, fried food, spring rolls, dumplings and more.
- ⑰ **YOSHICHO Honmachi 5**
A restaurant located at the entrance of the Machinami Quarter. Set menus of sushi and Japanese cuisine are served.
- ⑳ **Sweets Cafe COCORO Honmachi 4**
Built in the early 1900's, this play has a great atmosphere. Closed on Wednesdays. Lodging available (prior booking required).
- ㉑ **Restaurant MOTHER Honmachi 4**
Western-style food with a taste you can rely on. Lunch is recommended.
OPEN: 11:30 - 21:00 Closed on Mondays
- ㉒ **Shimohaga-tei Honmachi**
Stone-ground soba and herb courses are served at this 130 years old family house. There is a gallery as well.
- ㉓ **YAKUMO Honmachi 4**
Ducking under the shop curtain of YAKUMO, you are greeted with war in hearted Japanese cuisine. Closed on Mondays.
- ㉔ **SHALONE 20-ku**
The chef's recommended table d'hot is popular.
- ㉕ **GOJO Shinmachi 2**
Taste Japanese cuisine. Day off varies.
- ㉖ **Restaurant UORIN Honmachi 2**
We serve lunch at "Rinsuke". Our famous taimeshi (rice with sea-beam) is nice. Closed on Wednesdays.
- ㉗ **KATAOKA Diner Uchiko**
Japanese style Chinese noodles and inari sushi are popular.
- ㉘ **YUKIGI Uchiko**
Taste fresh sea food and cuisine caught at the local Uwa Sea. From lunch to full course dinner. Closed on Mondays.
- ㉙ **Godai In front of JR Uchiko Stn.**
Delicious sea food and cuisine caught at the local Uwa Sea Closed on Tuesdays. Lunch: 11:00 to 14:00, Dinner: 17:00 to 22:00 (prior booking required)

- Peach Picking.....Late July to mid August
- Pear Picking.....Early August to late September
- Persimmon Picking.....Early November to late November
- Grape Picking.....Mid August to late September
- Apple Picking.....Early Septembert to mid November
- Fig Picking.....Late September to late October

to get a souvenir

- ② **UCHINOKO-YA Gokoku**
Local food products and folk crafts are sold. A snack corner as a rest stop for tourists is provided.
- ③ **KONO Grocery Yokaichi**
A shop for Uchiko specialty products. Delivery of fresh vegetables and fruits to a destination within Japan is possible.
- ⑦ **NAGAIKE Folk Craft Yokaichi**
Uchiko hand-made products are ideal for souvenirs. Mingei Uchinoko.
- ⑧ **ATARASHI-YA Yokaichi**
The family used to run a dye house in the Edo Period. Many antique goods are exhibited. You can get hand-made Japanese paper crafts and special products.
- ⑩ **MORIBUN Amazake Tea House Sakamachi**
Established in 1893. We proudly deliver you our *amazake* (traditional sweet, low-alcoholic Japanese drink made from fermented rice), which was ardently made. The tea house sells hand-made specialty products. There is also a soy sauce museum.
- ⑪ **OMORI Japanese Wax Sakamachi**
The only hand-made wax shop in Uchiko-cho. The candles of this shop are uniquely made by layers of vegetable wax obtained from the nuts of the Japanese wax tree, *haze*.
- ⑬ **DOGO-YA Honmachi 8**
A hand-baked rice cracker shop established since the birth of the quarter.
- ⑱ **OKINO TSUKIMIDO Sakamachi 5**
Steamed yokan (sweet bean jelly) with chestnuts, rice cakes, Japanese waffle, and beautiful Japanese cakes created by the owner.
- ⑲ **SAKAMI KIGETSUDO Honmachi 5**
From the founder to the fourth generation, we've been creating Japanese sweets using Uchiko chestnuts. Get Uchiko specialty chestnut buns at the shop with the white wall and curtain.
- ㉒ **YAMAHIKO 20-ku**
One of Japan's top pheasant farms supplies fine pheasant meat. We deliver pheasant hot pot set to any destination within Japan.
- ㉔ **Omoto Confectionery Production Next to Uchiko-za**
Everything is home-made starting from the Uchiko specialty "kuri-manju" (chestnut bun).
- ⑳ **SAKAROKU Sake Brewery 13-ku**
Various pure sakés, warmed saké, and absolute local saké, Suimoken. We've been making local saké using selected rice and pure water.
- ㉒ **JIZAI KOBO (Inaka kaji KODAMA) Uchiko 1998-3**
Original candle stands made by a blacksmith. A craft workshop experience is also possible. There are coffee and cake, and various candle stands.
- ㉕ **RANPU Yokaichi**
The shop retains the feel of an antique residence and sells *aizome* (Indigo dyed) crafts, lace crafts, and other lovely goods.
- ㉖ **KOMACHI Sakamachi**
A sweets tea house serving local monaka (sweet bean cake), zenzai with white dumpling, green tea, and Uchiko souvenirs. At night time, the cafe changes to a bar serving local saké and wine.
- ㉗ **Roman Club Uchiko Yokaichi**
A shop with a nostalgic atmosphere which is a refurbished old residence. All goods including accessories are 1,000 yen/pc. Goods have the Uchiko style.
- ㉙ **KAZARI-YA Yokaichi**
Goods made of recycled glass. Desserts made of seasonable local fruits are also popular.
- ㉚ **KURA Honmachi 1**
A specialized shop for Ehime Uchiko local saké and shochu spirits. SAKAROKU Saké Brewery Daiginjo Saké Suimoken 720 ml /3,050 yen KAMEOKA Saké Brewery Iced saké Shizukuzake 720 ml /5,250 yen

for a taste of the history of Uchiko

- ㉛ **Kosho-ji Temple**
Zen temple with a large dormitory for monks. This famous temple has a 450-year history.
- ㉜ **Yokaichi Gokoku Machinami Quarter Preservation Center**
The north entrance of the Machinami Quarter Preservation Zone. The activities to preserve the quarter are introduced.
- ㉝ **Japanese Wax Museum / Kamihaga Residence**
One of a branch residence of a wealthy merchant, Haga family, who made a property due to mokuro wax production. Open to visitors. National Important Cultural Asset.
- ㉞ **Hon-Haga Residence**
An old residence of a wealthy merchant, who made a property due to mokuro wax production and export. Not-open to visitors. National Important Cultural Asset.
- ㉟ **Omura Residence**
Built in the 18th century. Not-open to visitors. National Important Cultural Asset.
- ㊱ **Machiya Museum**
Built in 1793. Open to visitors.
- ㊲ **Takahashi Residence**
The birth place of Ryutaro Takahashi who dedicated to the prosperity of Japanese beer market and who was the Minister of trade and industry. Lodging available (prior booking essential)
- ㊳ **Museum of Commercial and Domestic Life**
A museum reproducing the business and life style of a pharmacy in 1921, and a history and folk museum.
- ㊴ **Uchiko-za**
A Kabuki theater built in 1916.
- ㊵ **Wall Paint Exhibition**
Many wall paintings painted by Takeshi Ichikane are shown for visitors. Open from 9:00 to 17:00.
- ㊶ **Nakahaga-tei, the second house of an old chairman of a bank**
Nakahaga-tei is a branch family of Kamihaga-tei. Established as the second house of an old chairman of a bank. Beautiful garden suits for the luxurious architect is open for visitors. Adult: 200 yen/person

- ㊷ **Uchiko Taxi Honmachi 7**
Kindness is our policy. When you need a taxi, call Uchiko Taxi.
- ㊸ **JJ Travel Center/Ikeda Taxi Ekimae Street**
We want to show you Uchiko! A Jumbo taxi for 9 people is available. We promise satisfied sightseeing.
- ㊹ **Barber ICHIKANE Gokoku**
A tranquil shop you cannot see in the city anymore. Shaving and face massage for ladies are also available. Closed on Mon and the first Sun. Open from 9:00 to 19:00. Parking space for one car.

- ㊺ **Stellar Mira Ronden**
Enjoy eating surrounded by nature. A table reservation for a minimum of four guests offers a sourse of western dishes or *kaiseki* (Japanese traditional tea-ceremony dishes).
- ㊻ **Shinmachi-so Main shop Shinmachi**
Stay at Shinmachi-*so* which serves delicious meals, too time.
- ㊼ **MATSUNOYA Honmachi 2**
Japanese inn MATSUNOYA and restaurant SHOHACHI. We're proud of local and river fish cuisine from the Oda River, using local ingredients.
- ㊽ **High Plaza Uchiko Daba**
A quiet, inn located above the town. This inn decorates your memory of Uchiko.
- ㊾ **TSUKINO-YA Yokaichi**
A relaxing inn located in the traditional quarter where time goes slowly. Local food and our hospitality entertain you.
