Total travel distance **24.2km**



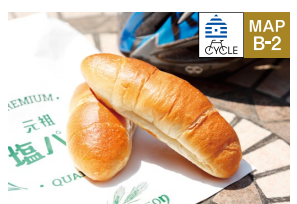

Matsubara Fountain
A spring near the Shigenobu River where a variety of flora and fauna inhabit. You can see fireflies in summer.



Akasaka Fountain Park
A spring 10m wide and 520m long, with about 160 cherry trees in the surrounding area.



Watanabe House
The former residence of a wealthy farmer completed in 1866 over 6 years. Some of the buildings are designated as National Important Cultural Properties.

A temple built for the soul of Emon Saburo; believed to be the person who started the Shikoku pilgrimage in the place where his residence was located.

Blue Line
A blue colored line that runs on the left side of roads, serves as a reliable guidepost to provide route information for cyclists.

Cycling rules & manners in Japan

- No riding side by side**
Riding side by side is prohibited except in areas with road signs indicating "riding side by side is permitted."
- Lights on at night**
Turn on your light not only at night but also in dark places such as tunnels.
- Do not park in prohibited areas**
Park your bicycle only in the designated areas and do not obstruct traffic.
