Most cases of fugu (pufferfish) poisoning are caused by amateur preparation at home. Please keep the following points in mind to enjoy fugu safely and deliciously.




About Fugu Poison (tetrodotoxin):

- Extremely potent toxin. (1,000x of potassium cyanide)
- · Not broken down by cooking or heating processes.
- Ingestion of toxic parts causes symptoms (numbness/vomiting) within 20 mins to 3 hrs; potentially fatal.
- · No effective antidote for tetrodotoxin available.







- Edible parts vary by fugu species.
- · It's difficult to tell edible fugu apart.
- · Expertise is required for preparation.
- Don't give away fugu you have caught.











- · A "Fugu Handler" license is required to prepare fugu.
- Don't accept any fugu prepared by an unlicensed person.
